1. (EWF, 1980) Mineral is almost definitely nephrite, from its hardness (6.5) and appearance; exact identification only possible by X-ray diffraction. A textile impression can be seen in the light-colored, altered surface of the jade, on the side without incised decoration. For similar impressions see W. B.
